

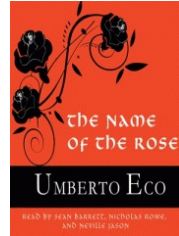

This list includes historical fiction titles, for a reader who prefers to learn history through reading fiction, and who likes to read history that covers long periods of time.

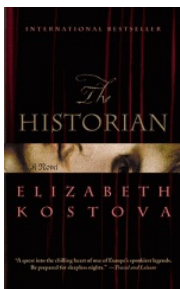

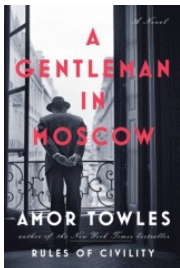

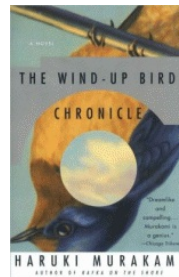
