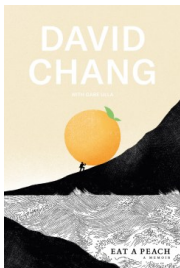

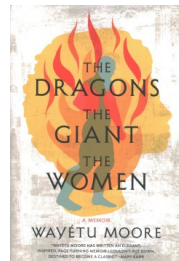

Chang, David, 1977- author.

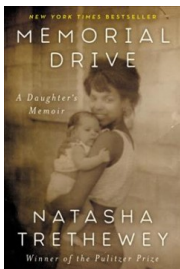

Moore, Wayaetu, author.

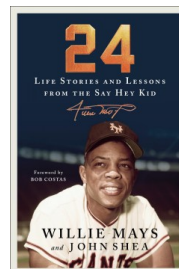

Trethewey, Natasha D., 1966- author.

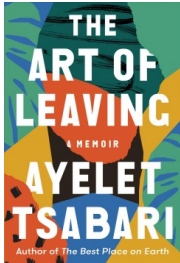
